FAMILY FOUNDATION APPOINTS NEW HEAD

Pittsburgh, PA, December 1, 2010---The Roy A. Hunt Foundation board of directors has announced the appointment of Tony Macklin as the foundation's new executive director, effective January 15, 2011.

Macklin follows Beatrice Carter, who joined the Foundation in 2000 and is retiring in March.

“Our decision to appoint Tony was unanimous,” said Tod Hunt, chair of the executive committee and former president of the family foundation for 24 years. “Bea created the infrastructure that has allowed us to become a strong family-run foundation. She has been a quiet stabilizing force behind a large family of individualists. We’re excited about the wealth of experience Tony brings to continue on this trajectory and bring along our growing fourth generation of trustees.”

Macklin spent 12 years at the Central Indiana Community Foundation in Indianapolis, most recently as its associate vice president. He opened a philanthropy consulting practice in 2008 when he moved to Pittsburgh with his wife, Alexis, who is director of the library and archives at the Heinz History Center. “The Hunt family has a

long history of strengthening communities through their entrepreneurship, active citizenship, and generosity. I'm excited to help them develop the next chapter of their shared philanthropic legacy through the foundation," Macklin said.

The Roy A. Hunt Foundation was established in 1966 by the will of Roy A. Hunt, the only son of Alfred E. Hunt, co-founder of Alcoa. In 1994, the foundation merged with the Hunt Foundation, which also was established by Roy A. Hunt in 1951 when he was chairman of Alcoa's executive committee. The Roy A. Hunt Foundation awards approximately \$3 million in grants annually to nonprofit organizations nationally. The trustees currently include one surviving son of Roy A. Hunt, eleven grandchildren, and twelve great grandchildren.
